

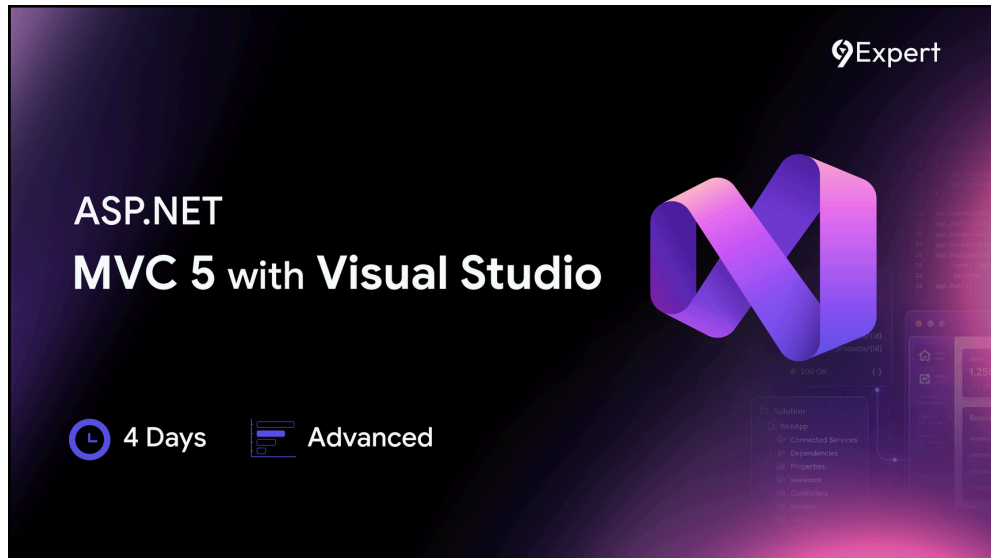

It emphasizes Object-Oriented Programming (OOP) principles and provides a structured approach to developing scalable and maintainable web applications.

- Model : Represents the business logic and data layer
- View : Handles the presentation and user interface layer
- Controller : Manages application logic and coordinates interactions between the Model and the View

Objectives

1. Develop web applications using the MVC framework
2. Create data models using ADO.NET and the Entity Framework
3. Build controllers to manage core application logic
4. Design user interfaces using the Razor View Engine
5. Configure routing to support page navigation and content rendering
