This course teaches business application development using Power Apps in conjunction with Power Automate, focusing on low-code techniques for data management, workflow automation, Power BI integration, barcode scanning, and mobile camera functionality. Participants will learn how to store data in SharePoint and Excel Online and will engage in hands-on workshops to

build employee management systems, email notification applications, and inventory management solutions.

2. Build applications for searching, editing, and deleting data, with storage in SharePoint and Excel Online.
3. Trigger and manage workflows in Power Automate directly from Power Apps.
4. Create charts and integrate Power BI reports within Power Apps.
